## Points given according to status:

- 1. **0-3** indicates the need for <u>resuscitation</u> of the infant
  - a. If ventilation is inadequate or absent, and the pulse is less than 100 bpm, provide bag-valve-mask ventilation by using gentle puffs just sufficient to inflate infant's lungs at a rate of 40 per minute. Re-evaluate respiratory status after one or two minutes of ventilation. Continue ventilation if necessary.
  - b. If infant's heart rate is less than 80 beats per minute, perform CPR
- 2. **4-6** indicates the need for <u>urgent intervention</u>. The infant may need to be ventilated with bag-valve-mask and supplemental oxygen.
- 3. 7-10 indicates routine supportive care
