

Supplies needed:

- 1. 50 mL NS bag
- 2. 50-60 cc syringe with needle
- 3. Alcohol prep pads aseptic technique for medication preparation
- 4. Sodium Thiosulfate vial

Dosage and administration:

Adult

- 12.5 grams (50 mL of a 25% solution) IV over 10 minutes.
 - 1. Start with a 50 mL NS bag.
 - 2. Draw 40 mL out of the bag and discard.
 - 3. Mix 50 mL of Sodium Thiosulfate to the bag.
 - 4. Attach a 10 gtt/mL (macro) infusion set.
 - 5. Completely infuse mixed bag at 1 gtt/sec or 60 gtts/min.

Pediatric

- 1.2 mL/kg of a 25% solution to a maximum of 50 mL IV/IO over 10 minutes.
 - 1. Draw out Sodium Thiosulfate 1.2 mL/kg.
 - 2. Mix into a 50 mL NS bag.
 - 3. Attach a 10 gtt/mL (macro) infusion set.
 - 4. Completely infuse mixed bag at 1 gtt/sec or 60 gtts/min.

NOTE: If the pediatric patient meets or exceeds the adult dose of 12.5 gm (50 mL), follow the above Sodium Thiosulfate infusion instructions and administration for adults.



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
