

Introduction

Wound packing is for compressible (external) hemorrhage not amenable to limb tourniquet use or as an adjunct to tourniquet downgrade/conversion.

Procedure

BLS

- 1. Identify the extent of injury and bleeding site.
- 2. Open foil pouch and remove hemostatic dressing. If hemostatic dressing is not available, use gauze roll dressing.
- 3. Identify the source of bleeding.
- 4. With the dressing, apply direct digital pressure to the source of bleeding.
- 5. Pack dressing completely into the wound track. Use enough of the dressing to fill the wound and contact all bleeding surfaces. More than one dressing may be required.
- 6. Pack an absorbent dressing in a gauze roll, on top of the hemostatic dressing(s)
- 7. Apply constant pressure to the bleeding site for at least 3 minutes.
- 8. Secure the entire dressing with a pressure bandage.
